WESTBOUND HATEM BRIDGE TRAFFIC TO BE DETOURED TEMPORARILY OVERNIGHT

REVISED

WHAT: The westbound lane of the Thomas J. Hatem Memorial Bridge (US 40) will be closed temporarily.

WHEN: **Weather and traffic volumes permitting**, westbound traffic may be detoured from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning **Thursday and Friday, March 4 and 5, and Sunday, March 7 through Tuesday, March 9**. Eastbound traffic will not be impacted.

The detour route will direct motorists to northbound MD 222, to southbound I-95, to eastbound MD 155, to westbound US 40.

Please note there is no toll on southbound I-95.

WHY: Crews will be setting grid deck on the westbound portion of the bridge.
